Dear Parent/Guardian

I hope you are all well and adapting to working from home in the best way possible.

Please could I signpost the advice to parents for working from home which appears on the website and may help in establishing routines. Please see www.moorside.staffs.sch.uk "Latest News" – Working from Home.

We are aware that parents are not necessarily teachers and some parents are finding it difficult to support their children with the content of the work. Could I encourage parents to contact their child's teacher if they are having problems and similarly we have created a folder of websites or resources that might help.

Our staff are currently preparing resources which might need to be used after Easter. I would suggest that the work that has been set so far, although intended for just 2 weeks, might take your child the full 4 weeks up to the end of the Easter holidays. We will monitor this situation.

Although we know that the GCSE exams have been cancelled for this year, I would still encourage Year 11 students to complete the work that has been set. It is important that they have no gaps in their knowledge and understanding before they embark on their next stage of their education, training or employment. We are still awaiting guidance from the Government on how GCSE grades will be generated this year. It is important that Year 11 students keep hold of all their books, assessments and exams because they may be required for evidence.

These are difficult times and all the effort you are making to support your child with their education is greatly appreciated. I hope it is not too long before we can return to education as normal.
