Dear Parent/Guardian,

In preparation for next week please find attached **A Parent/Pupil Journey Planning Map which has been prepared by the Local Authority** to assist you with planning how your child will get to school next week.


Due to the current restrictions we would advise that your child avoids using public transport. We would encourage all students to walk or cycle to school and if travelling by car, park further away from school to encourage your child to walk more and help us to maintain a steady flow of students into school.

If there is no alternative and your child has to catch the public transport then the Scraggs 'Pay as you Go' bus from Hanley will operate as usual with one bus in the morning and two buses at night which pick up on site. These will be 'School Run' buses and will not be picking up members of the public. On this basis students can sit two to a seat, however, places will be limited because there can be no standing up. Students will be expected to use the hand sanitiser onboard the bus and will be expected to wear masks at all times whilst on the bus. They will need to remove the mask when they arrive at school and then place the mask into a bag and keep in their school bag.

If your child lives between Meir and Weston Coyney we will continue to operate two Copeland coaches from Weston Coyney. You will require a bus pass for these coaches which can be purchased through reception. This will be done through parent pay in the first week back in September. Any new Year 7 students who have informed the Head of Year 7 Mr Philips they require a place and existing bus pass holders in Years 8 to 11 can catch the bus in the first week.

The first coach will pick up at 8.10am from the outside the flower shop in Weston Coyney. This coach will also pick up from Coupe drive.
A second coach will set off from the Co-op in Meir at 8.10am and pick up any remaining students from the Flower shop and from Coupe Drive on its route to school. Students will be allocated a seat on the coach and they must always sit in that seat. They will be expected to hand sanitise and will have to wear a mask at all times whilst on board. Anybody who does not comply with these rules will have their pass revoked. Students will be asked to remove their masks on site and told to place their mask in a bag which can then be put inside their school bag.
